## TRAINING METHODS

- A combination of distance learning courses and on-site seminars.

## COSTS AND CONDITIONS

Costs for GP Professional Training will vary depending on the duration, location, number of modules, format, and tutoring needs.

Sample tuition\* per person for a group of 8 to 10 participants:

- €500 – 2 days of professional training, 1 module, in-house or at CGP
- €1,300 – 1 week of professional training, in-house or at CGP
- €2,100 – 2 weeks of professional training, in-house or at CGP
- €4,000 – 2 months of professional training by distance learning

*\*Please note that costs for accommodation as well as travel expenditures are not included and must be covered individually by participants or by the funding organization.*
